Books Build Better Brains: How Early Literacy is Key to Early Brain and Chid Development

Dr. Navsaria will discuss the critical importance of the first 1,000 days of life and the key role human relationships and interactions play in that time period. The importance of early literacy, along with key concepts about literacy development will be reviewed. The structure and concept behind the Reach Out and Read program (which provides early literacy promotion) will be discussed in this context.

The Power of Self-Correcting: Why it Matters!

Participants will examine the "window into processing" that self-correction presents: a reader must monitor (notice an error) and then take some action (an in-the-head strategy) in order to selfcorrect. Using running records, teaching decisions to encourage self-correcting (monitoring and fix-up strategies) will be demonstrated. Saturday, November 5th Emily Reddy Breakfast Meeting (8:30-11:00)

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Talking About Text: Who Owns the Conversation?

This session will offer multiple ways to grow conversations around text in your classroom. We will discuss the importance of oracy in the classroom, how to prepare kids for discussion, growing student ownership of the thinking, and the teacher's role in facilitating deep conversations around text. In addition, we will discuss ways to assess student comprehension through conversation, as well as evaluate the strength of the discussion.

Up Close and Personal: A Sophisticated Look at Assessment and Its Impact on Students


